**Re-Entry Period:** 48 hours after the last treatment

**Residual Activity:** About 2-3 weeks.

**Mixing:** Mixable with the most known pesticides.

Not miscible with highly alkaline or highly acidic materials.

**Storage:** Store D-TETRAMAX 10 EC in the original tightly closed container in a cool, dry and ventilated place away from children, food, feedstuffs and water after handling.

Remove contaminated clothing and water.

Protect against sunlight for prolonged periods.

Store in an authorized pesticide store.

#### First aid:

**Skin or Clothing Contact:** Remove all contaminated clothes and shoes.

Wash off immediately with soap and plenty of water (15-20 minutes).

Get medical attention immediately.

**Eye Contact:** Flush eyes with tap water for at least 15 minutes. Consult an ophthalmologist.

**If Inhaled:** Remove from exposure area to fresh air immediately. If breathing has stopped, perform artificial respiration. Keep person warm and at rest. Treat symptomatically and supportive.

Get medical attention immediately.

**If Ingestion:** Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water. DO NOT induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to unconscious person. Consult a physician Toxicological information: It is moderately hazardous, dermal contact may cause allergic sensitization, eye contact may cause irritation.

**Notice To Doctor:** Symptoms of Poisoning: Nervousness, anxiety, convulsions, allergic manifestations.
